## FROZEN TREATS

FREEZE WATERMELON CHUNKS, CHOPPED HERBS IN ICE CUBES, OR VEGGIE MIX IN MUFFIN TINS.



## ELECTROLYTES IN WATER

ADD POULTRY-SAFE ELECTROLYTES OR A SPLASH OF APPLE CIDER VINEGAR TO SUPPORT HYDRATION.

## SOLAR COOP FAN

A SOLAR FAN HELPS CIRCULATE AIR AND COOL THE COOP.



## FROZEN WATER BOTTLE TRICK

FREEZE WATER BOTTLES AND PLACE THEM IN SHADY REST SPOTS OR NESTING BOXES. (REMOVE THE PAPER LABEL FIRST)

## PLENTY OF SHADE

USE UMBRELLAS, TARPS, OR FLOCK-SAFE PLANTS LIKE SUNFLOWERS/BUSHES FOR NATURAL SHADE.

## COOL CERAMIC TILE

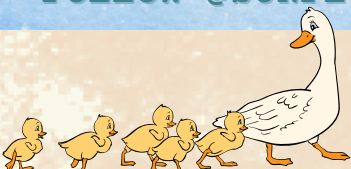
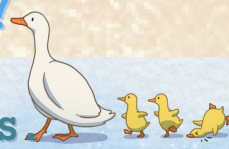
CHILL A TILE OR PAVER IN THE FRIDGE AND PLACE IT IN THE RUN - THEY'LL SIT ON IT TO COOL OFF.

- ◆ Freeze flock-safe herbs, fruits, or veggies in muffin tins for a cooling treat
- ◆ Add electrolytes or ACV to drinking water to support hydration
- ◆ Use a solar fan + chilled tile or paver for a flock cool-down zone
- ◆ Provide shade with tarps, umbrellas, or flock-safe plants like sunflowers or lemongrass
